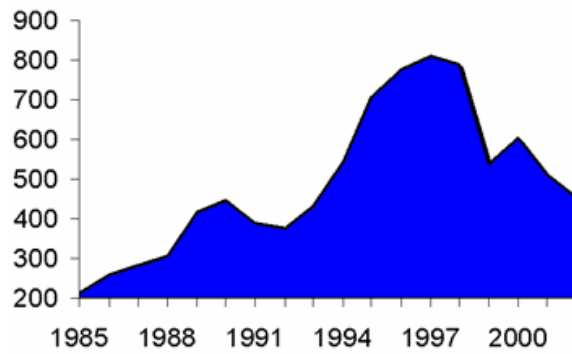

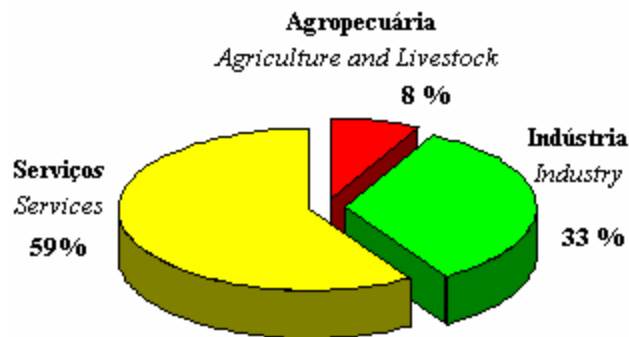

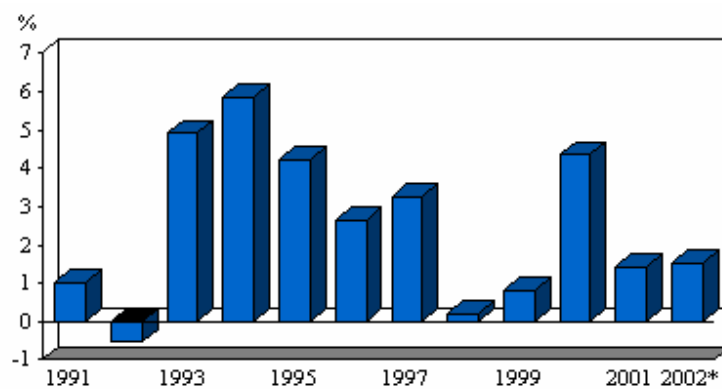
Sectorial distribution of GDP (2001)

Total GDP - Growth Rates



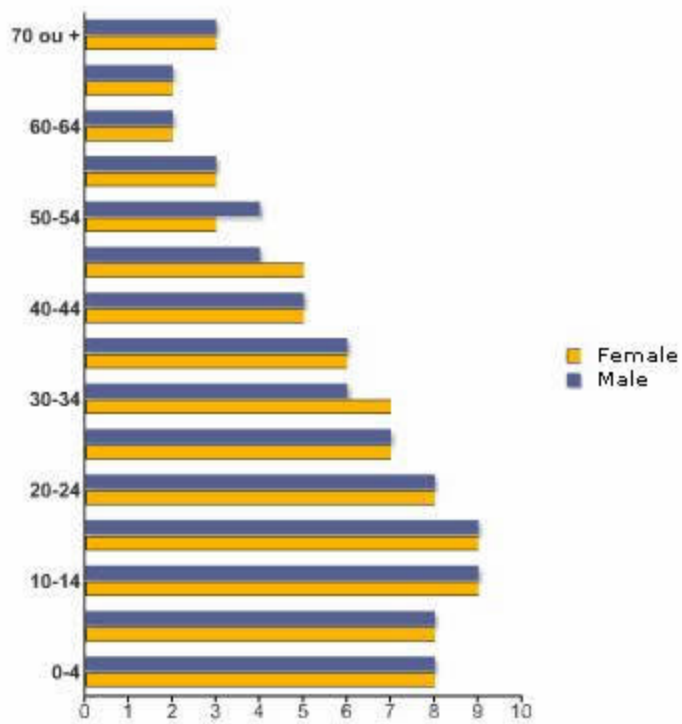

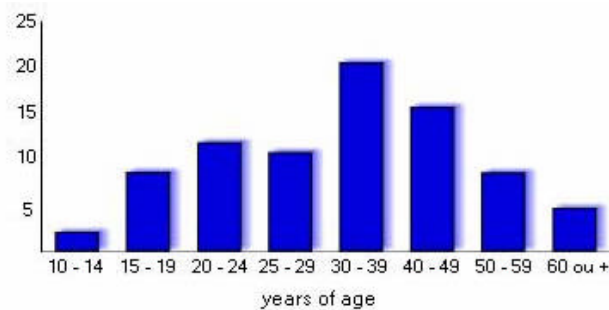

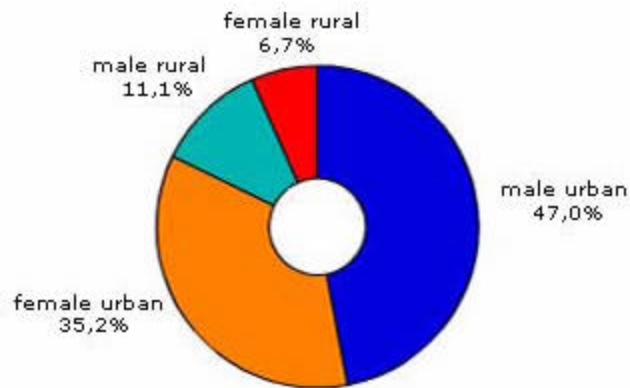
Population 2000

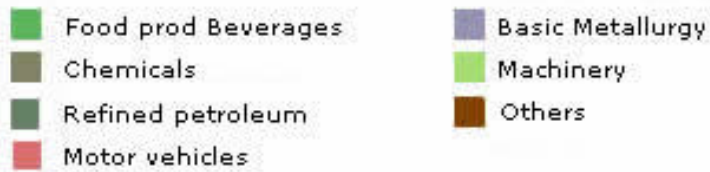

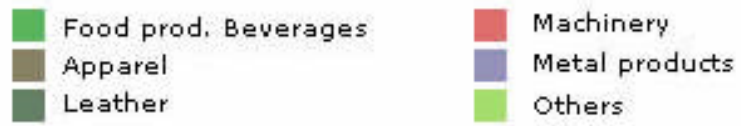
